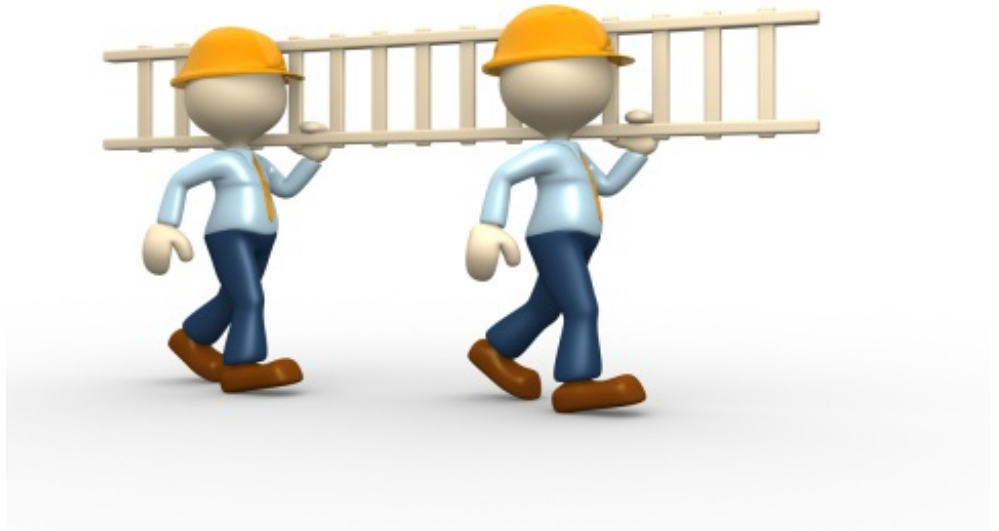
Maintenance made easy
